



Grade Point Average Calculation Method for Graduate Courses

GPA calculation formula for graduate courses:

$$\text{Grade Point Average} = \frac{\sum (\text{course grade points} \times \text{credits})}{\sum \text{credits}}$$

Notes:

1. Conversion formula from scores out of the 100-point system to course grade points:

$$\text{Course grade points} = 4 - 3 \times (100 - x)^2 / 1600$$

where x is the score out of the 100-point system. According to the formula, when x = 100, the course grade point is 4; when x=60, 1; when x is below 60, 0.

2. Conversion from the five-scale grading system to course grade points:

Excellent: 4

Good: 3.5

Fair: 2.8

Pass: 1.7

Fail: 0

3. Courses graded on a two-scale system are not counted as grade points.
4. Courses with a "T" grade for credit recognition are not counted as grade points.
5. Exemption courses with an "EX" grade are not counted as grade points
